Matter arising:

Merseytravel meeting to discuss January to June disruption under the Mersey in 2017. Members of CTC and MCC to consider data on numbers of cycles seen on these journeys.

Cycle forum minutes were reviewed, including a Breeze cycle presentation (see SB comments below).

Sue Booth introduced herself and gave us a brief synopsis about herself and formation of Fab Ladies cycling group 8 years ago. Sue had marshalled for a spring '50' and noticed only 4% of competitors were female.

She started with 5 mile runs each month on Saturday mornings. Notes that Breeze riders are a British Cycling development that commenced after her efforts to raise the profile of lady cyclists.

Key elements: Run by women. Somewhere local. Parking/Café (she 'has' 50 cafes!). Pace is steady, ie 10mph./ faster group / slow beginners.

Rationale: bring women into group to feed into CTC rides. Not about going fast! Speed of group is key. Not distance. Group numbers limited to 10 for safety reasons, ideal number is 8. Larger groups are split for safety. Sign in sheets include emails plus next of kin.

Note that tacks have been found on the Chester Greenway and riders should be vigilant.

Rides also take place Wed evening, April / August. Opportunity for crossover of riders between Chester and Merseyside. Possible ride leader training Sept / Oct. Events include Rafa 100K, 17th July, also one weekend per annum with YHA; there is a ride from Holyhead back to Chester over two days, which is very successful.
